This is a one to two semester (or monthly equivalent) internship, and can be scheduled according to the intern's academic calendar and requirements.

This position merges research, analysis, editorial, and administration work with high-level forms of planning and promotional outreach to noted scholars and organizers from around the world. The intern will be tasked with brainstorming, implementing, and following through on new ideas to bolster conference participation and coverage. This position provides a great opportunity to develop public relations skills and allows for unique opportunities to creatively engage various teams, individuals, and organizations.

We're a small organization with a dedicated group of organizers, staff and volunteers with a passion for social justice, community organizing, and progressive change. Located in the CUNY Graduate Center, you'll be working in an interesting (and very relaxed) office where you'll interact, meet, and learn from scholars, activists, authors and artists in a rewarding intellectual political milieu.

Primary Responsibilities

- Develop and execute media outreach and publicity promotional strategies
- Engage in outreach to scholars, organizations, under-represented progressive and social justice groups and individuals
- Engage in building and developing relationships with the groups and individuals mentioned above
- Engage former speakers, organizers, and activists in email and phone communications along with in-person meetings
- Work with publicity contacts in medium- and large-scale organizations (e.g., schools) for posting and expanding publicity materials (leaflets, brochures, posters)
- Update and organize our publicity/public relations and press contacts database
- Assist with mailings, print production, and other administrative duties
- Help administer all phases of event planning and organizing from initial contact to conference and event scheduling
